

# Hazard Vulnerability Analysis Education

## Purpose

- Facilitate the enhancement of current HVA processes and outcomes.
- Provide tools and resources to assist with improvement of HVAs within healthcare facilities.
- Examine mechanisms to coordinate and integrate the HVAs of multiple healthcare facilities in order to gain an understanding of the vulnerability of regional healthcare capability.

## Target Audience

Any person who participates in the development of the facility or agency HVA. This might include the emergency manager, clinical care providers, security, materials management, plant operations, etc.

## Educational Offerings

**Webinar:** Two webinars will be provided.

These will discuss the foundation and methodology necessary to develop an HVA. These will be identical presentations. Anyone who is interested in HVAs or participate in the development should attend.

**Workshop:** Three workshops will be provided.

Participants will share techniques of hazard identification, define expectations of support agencies, and build relationships with agencies likely to respond during an event. Attendees should include those who develop the HVA & community partners like county EM, EMS, and public health. Attendance is limited to 40 per session.
