

STRIKE TEAM FORMS

Time: 30 Minutes

INTRODUCTION:

This exercise is based on an Ambulance Strike Team Leader Preparation. The student groups will determine what forms are needed prior to activation of an ambulance strike team. In addition to determining what forms are needed, the students will review the ICS Form 201, ICS FORM 211 and ICS 214.

DIRECTIONS:

- A. Break into groups. The instructor should configure the groups based on the student profiles. A mix of agencies, and/or experience level should be reflected in each group.
- B. You will have ten minutes to determine what forms an ambulance strike team leader may need prior to an incident.
- C. The groups will provide the list of forms to the class.
- D. The instructor will review several of the forms with the class. The class will have 15 minutes to complete the forms with as much information as provided.

Hurricane Kim
Ambulance Strike Team/Medical Task Force Deployment

It is September 2. The North Carolina EOC has requested the N.C. Office of EMS (OEMS) to activate an Ambulance Strike Team to respond to the NCEM Resource Coordination Center in Kinston N.C. You are assigned as the Ambulance Strike Team Leader. The Strike Team is to respond routine traffic to the Resource Coordination Center (RCC) in Kinston for possible deployment to the affected counties impacted by Hurricane Kim (category three hurricane). The OEMS Coordinator has requested you take an Ambulance Strike Team Leader trainee, if possible. It is now 1500 hours and the Ambulance Strike Team/Medical Task Force is scheduled to meet at 1700 hours at the CapRAC Warehouse. The CapRAC Warehouse is located at on Management Way in Garner behind the WakeMed Garner HealthPlex.

On your arrival at the assembly location at the CapRAC Warehouse, all five of the ambulances forming your strike team are present. A message for you indicates that a trainee is not available and you should not wait to respond.
